There are seven penthouses at the top of this former furniture factory, widely credited as being the first development of its kind to hit Kentish Town, but from ground level you'd never know. The one, two and three-bedroom apartments are housed in a brand new two floor roof extension on top of the original building and are built and interior designed in a contemporary style to contrast with the rest of the Victorian red brick building.



The flats have glass curtain walls with sliding panels, which lead out onto L-shaped terraces, accessible from the living and bedrooms and made glamorous by decking, landscaping and downlighting on the parapet walls.
